

## Foreigners under COVID-19 quarantine are forbidden from leaving the designated venue

- ☐ Foreigners placed in quarantine due to the COVID-19 outbreak are forbidden from leaving the area designated by the public health authorities, and visits to Immigration (branch) Offices are restricted as well.
- ☐ In addition, starting April 1, 2020, foreign nationals entering the Republic of Korea are placed under a mandatory 14-day quarantine by the public health authorities, either at his/her residence or at designated facilities and are not allowed to leave the designated venue.

### Entrants subject to Quarantine and Exemptions, Effective April 1, 2020

- ☞ Long-stay visitors ⇒ 14-day self-quarantine (those without local addresses are quarantined at designated facilities)
- ☞ Short-stay visitors ⇒ 14-day quarantine at facilities designated by the health authorities
- ☞ Exemptions from Quarantine ⇒ Those exempted from quarantine requirements are closely monitored after undergoing medical screening at points of entry (Self Diagnosis Mobile App, Telephone Check by Health Authority)
  - Entrants with A1(Diplomat), A2(Government Official) and A3(International Agreement) status
  - Entrants with essential business/academic/public interest/humanitarian purposes who have been issued, prior to entry into the ROK, with Isolation Exemption Certificate by the Korean Embassy

☐ Please make sure to visit a jurisdictional immigration office AFTER treatment is complete and the quarantine is lifted, as no punishments will be imposed for exceeding the Period of Stay or the reporting period while under quarantine/treatment.

※ Registered aliens (or who reported his/her residence): Required to visit within 30 days AFTER completion of treatment/quarantine  
Short-term visitors: Required to visit within 10 days AFTER completion of treatment/quarantine

Failure to comply with health authority orders, or leaving the designated quarantine venue while in treatment/quarantine will result in strict consequences including criminal punishment, revocation of visa and permission of stay and deportation.
